

TBC Prayer Calendar for August 2021
You are invited to FAST & PRAY the 1st of the month 7:00 a.m.-noon.

1 Fast & pray today. *But we (elders) will devote ourselves to prayer & to the ministry of the Word...we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work & increasing in the knowledge of God.* Acts 6:4, Col 1:9-10 Praying this for our elders/wives: Jared/Brandy, Travis/Marlene, Joey/Kelly, Mark/Tracy, Bill/Sharon.

2 *May you be strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance & patience with joy, giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.* Col 1:11-12
Praying for our deacons/wives: Harold/Kathy, Mike/Leslie, Troy/Patty, Jim A/Mary, Jim S/Melanie, Todd/Amber, Dan/Teresa, Richard/Diane, Ryan/Natalie, Brandon/Kinsey, Chris/Meghan, John/Patty, Mark/Tressa, Amos/Jennica, Brandon/Caitlin, Scott/Diane, Doug/Jennifer, & Jacob White.

3 Praying for future elders & deacons from I Tim 3:1-7...*above reproach, husband of one wife, sober minded, self controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, not a drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money, manage his own household well, keeping children submissive... not a recent convert... well thought of by outsiders....*

4 *Therefore my beloved (staff), be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.* I Cor. 15:58 Praying this for TBC Staff- Jared, Scott, Patty, Troy, Kirk, Sam, Jacob, future Admin assistant, & future Children's Director. While not on staff, we also want to include our new treasurer, Robert Goumaz.

5 *Go therefore & make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father & of the Son & of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.*
Mt 28:18-20 Pray that TBC will live out our Mission Statement of: Knowing God and Making Him Known

6 *To open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light & from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins & a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.* Acts 26:18 Praying this verse for any unbelievers at TBC, in our families, Tulsa and the world as well as praying for TBC Missions Committee as they strategize outreach for the church.

7 *Let the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my rock & my redeemer.* Ps.19:14 Hearts at TBC would be surrendered to the Lord resulting in grace filled words flowing out to one another.

8 *Take My yoke upon you, & learn from me, for I am gentle & lowly in heart, & you will find rest for your souls.* Mt 11:29 Women would be eager to learn from Him, registering this month for the fall Bible studies & the September retreat.

9 *But be doers of the Word, & not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.* Jms.1:22 Apply this week what we learned yesterday.

10 *Church in Laodicea...I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot.* Rev. 3:15a
TBC would be wholehearted in loving and serving the Lord. If lukewarm, we'd repent and be zealous.

11 *Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them....*Rms. 12:6a
All at TBC would use their gifts which the Holy Spirit gives in grace to serve one another.

12 *Complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord & of one mind....striving together for the faith of the gospel.* Phil. 2:2(ESV), 1:27 (NKJ) For the sake of the gospel we would be committed, striving after, willing to make every effort for relational unity in each home and at TBC.

13 *You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus...* II Tim. 2:1
Praying this for all teachers at TBC, the Children's Director, teachers in schools & students as they prepare to start back.

14 *Let my cry come before you, O LORD; give me understanding according to your word! Let my plea come before you; deliver me according to your word.* Ps. 119:169-170 TBC would be a people who spend time alone daily with the Lord, reading & praying His Word.

15 *Church in Pergamum...you have some there who hold the teaching of Balaam...you have some who hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans...* Rev.2:14b-15a TBC would be dedicated to truth and sound doctrine until the Lord returns.

16 *Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ...Phil. 1:27a (NKJ)* Apply this week what we learned yesterday, living lives consistent to what we believe, teach & preach.

17 *As for me, I will call upon God & the LORD shall save me. Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud & He shall hear my voice.* Ps. 55:16-17 (NKJ) TBC would be a church devoted to prayer.

18 *And this (we) pray, that (our) love may abound still more & more in knowledge & all discernment, that (we) may approve the things that are excellent, that (we) may be sincere & without offense till the day of Christ...* Phil. 1:9-10 NKJ

19 *...filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.* Phil 1:11 Glorify God

20 *And all who believed were together and had all things in common.* Acts 2:44 As our love relationship with our Lord goes deeper, so all relationships at TBC would go deeper.

21 Take time to read and pray through Ps. 19:7-11 praising, confessing, thanking and interceding for TBC, yourself and family.

22 *Church in Philadelphia...I know your works. Behold, I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to shut. I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown.* Rev. 3:8a,11 TBC would seize open doors to spread the gospel.

23 *...since it is written, "You shall be holy, as I am Holy"* I Pet. 1:16 Confession and repentance of yesterday's convictions.

24 *O Timothy, guard the deposit entrusted to you.* I Tim 6:20 Each would guard the gospel & it would have precedence overall.

25 *Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering and come before him! Worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness; I Chron. 16:29* Hearts overflowing with worship.

26 *Church in Thyatira...I know your works, your love & faith & service & patient endurance, & that your latter works exceed the first. But I have this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel...* 2:19-20a Increasing holiness would be a TBC hallmark.

27 *One thing I have asked of the LORD, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD & to inquire in His temple.* Ps. 27:4

28 *He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' "* Mt. 21:13a When each SS class meets, time would be devoted to prayer & from the calendar, encouraging individuals to continue during the week.

29 *Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your Name."* Mt 6:9 All would treasure God prayerfully.

30 *"Your Kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."* Mt 6:10 We would be intentional in walking in the Spirit, applying what we have learned this week, being transformed into His likeness.

31 *(They are) not afraid of bad news, (their) heart is firm, trusting in the Lord.* Ps.112:7 We would be trusting God collectively.

Thank You Lord for the prayers You have heard this month and answering according to Your will.
For from Him & through Him & to Him are all things. To Him be glory (at TBC) forevermore. Rms. 11:36
