November 2021

Consider this: Join the Prayer Committee in fasting and prayer on the morning of Monday, Nov 1st, as we enter this season of feasting and gratitude.

Be thankful --

1. **--when petitioning the Father.** Phil 4:6 ...do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
2. **– in serving.** II Cor 4:15 For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God.
3. **– knowing you’re offering a worshipful sacrifice.** Heb 13:15 KJV By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.
4. **–for all your circumstances- even those you don’t like much.** I Thess 5:18 ...give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
5. **–because to not be thankful is the first step away from God.** Rom 1:21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened.
6. **--and make your gratitude obvious to everyone around.** Col 2:6-7 Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.
7. **--for the victory Christ has assured eternally and continues to give presently.** I Cor 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
8. **--as you pray for one another today.** Eph 1:16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers...
9. **–that the Creator of all is personally known by you.** Psalm 118:28 You are my God, and I will give thanks to you; you are my God; I will extol you.
10. **–that in a world of turmoil, Jesus offers you his peace.** Col 3:15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.
11. **–that your love for and appreciation of one another can deepen and grow.** II Thess 1:3 We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing.
12. **–for the gift of forgiveness, eternal life, and adoption into God’s family.** II Cor 9:15 Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!
13. **–that his steadfast love never changes.** Psalm 107:1 Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.
14. **–that when you were helpless to save yourself, he rescued you, then gave you work to do.** Jonah 2:9 “But I with the voice of thanksgiving will sacrifice to you; what I have vowed I will pay. Salvation belongs to the LORD!”
15. **–that you can approach God’s throne in prayer.** Col 4:2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.
16. **–for God’s good creation.** I Tim 4:4 For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving.

Be thankful...

17. **–that you have been given the words of life to share with the world.** I Chron 16:8 Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples!
18. **–because thanksgiving brings glory to God.** Psalm 50:23 The one who offers thanksgiving as his sacrifice glorifies me...
19. **–that God provides so you can be generous so that thanksgiving will abound.** II Cor 9:11 You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God.
20. **–that he is your strength and shield.** Psalm 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped; my heart exults, and with my song I give thanks to him.
21. **–that you can come into his presence.** Psalm 95:2 Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!
22. **–that you can do things in his name and for his glory.** Col 3:17 And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
23. **–that you can bear witness to his wonderful deeds.** Psalm 9:1 I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds.
24. **–for his amazing grace.** I Cor 1:4 I will give thanks to my God always because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus...
25. **–for everything, always.** Eph 5:20 ...giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
26. **–that you can share in the inheritance of the saints.** Col 1:12 ...giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.
27. **–that you can worship your Creator, the Lord God.** Psalm 100:3-4 Know that the LORD, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise!
28. **–for his wonderful works. List some you can think of.** Psalm 107:8 Let them thank the Lord for his steadfast love, for his wondrous works to the children of man!
29. **–for music to praise and give thanks.** Ezra 3:11 And they sang responsively, praising and giving thanks to the LORD...
30. **–because God notices when you do.** Luke 17:15-18 Then one of them when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan. Then Jesus answered, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?"
