

October 2021 TBC Prayer Calendar

Celebrating the Reformation by praying through the 5 solas with thanksgiving to God! By way of reminder, the five solas are five points that summarize the Biblical theology recovered & proclaimed during the Protestant Reformation. **Join us on October 1, 9am-12 to fast and pray.** Scriptures from ESV.

1. Sola Scriptura (Scripture alone) The Bible is the sole written divine revelation & alone can bind the conscience of the believer absolutely. It is our highest authority & only His inspired Word can command us absolutely.

Praising God that ALL scripture is breathed out by God & profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, & for training in righteousness. II Timothy 3:16. God, use Your Word in me, my family and TBC to grow us into Your likeness and shine forth Your glory. Men's fellowship tonight.

2. *My soul melts away for sorrow; strengthen me according to your word. Ps. 119:28* May we run to His Word to teach us in how to deny ourselves, take up our cross, & follow Him.

3. *For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance & through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. Rom. 15:4* Thank you Father for Your words to us. Instruct us today & infuse us with renewed hope in You today.

4. *...preach the Word; be ready in season & out of season; reprove, rebuke & exhort, with complete patience & teaching. For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, & will turn away from listening to the truth & wander off into myths.*

II Tim. 4:2-4 Holy Spirit, guide me in praying these verses.

5. *Your word is a lamp to my feet & a light to my path. Ps. 119:105* May we look to His Word to give us the direction in the decisions that are before us and the path we are to follow.

6. *Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching & admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms & hymns & spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. Col. 3:16* May this be true of the saints of TBC.

7. Sola Christus (In Christ alone) Jesus Christ is the only mediator through whose work we are redeemed. He alone is our Lord, Savior & King.

In the beginning was the Word, & the Word was with God, & the Word was God.... And the Word became flesh & dwelt among us, & we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace & truth. John 1:1,14 Praising God today for His Son in all His glory, thanking Him for coming to earth. Men's Bibles studies start

8. *In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace which He lavished upon us, in all wisdom & insight... Eph 1:7-8* Remembering the day of our salvation with deep gratitude & worship.

9. *For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. Romans 10:13* Praying for the lost.

10. *All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself & gave us the ministry of reconciliation... II Cor. 5:18* Holy Spirit, guide me in praying this verse for myself, my family and for TBC.

11. *Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.... Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy & find grace to help in time of need. Heb. 4:14,16* I am needy Lord, help! Grow my confidence in You, that You hear & answer.

12. *Therefore God has highly exalted him & bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow in heaven & on earth & under the earth, & every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Phil. 2:9-10* Holy Spirit, guide me in how to pray these verses.

13. **Sola Fide** (Justification is by **faith alone**) The merit of Christ, imputed to us by faith, is the sole ground of our acceptance by God, by which our sins are remitted, & imputed to Christ.

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Eph 2:8-10 Thanking God today for His gracious gift of salvation, walking in good works by His grace.

14. *Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists & that He rewards those who seek Him. Heb. 11:1,6* Grow our faith in You Who is our greatest reward.

15. *Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, & **we rejoice in hope of the glory of God!** Rms. 5:1-2*

17. *The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" Lk. 17:5* May this be our desire & prayer as well.

18. *But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven & tossed by the wind. James 1:6* May we be faithfully offering up prayers in faith.

19. **Sola Gratia** (In **grace alone**) Our salvation rests solely on the work of God's grace for us. We are saved by the grace of God alone. *...so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:7* Praise God from whom ALL blessings flow!

20. *Therefore the LORD waits to be gracious to you, & therefore He exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the LORD is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for him. Is. 30:18*

21. *As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace. I Pet. 4:10* Help me Lord to be eagerly looking for ways to serve You by serving others.

22. *The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen. Rev. 22:21* May we be keenly aware of His grace today. Men's retreat.

23. *May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. II Pet 1:2*

24. *You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus... II Tim. 2:1*

25. **Sola Gloria** (to the **glory of God alone**) To God alone belongs the glory. As His children, we purpose to live for the glory of God alone. *Be exalted, O God, above the heavens! Let your glory be over all the earth! Ps. 108:5*

26. *Not to us, O LORD, not to us, but to your name give glory, for the sake of Your steadfast love & Your faithfulness! Ps.115:1*

27. *Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; He is to be feared above all gods. Ps. 96:3-4* May this be a growing reality at TBC.

28. *"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!" Lk. 2:14* Constant praise.

29. *Saying with a loud voice, "Fear God, and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment is come: and worship Him who made heaven and earth, and the sea, and springs of water." Rev. 14:7 NKJV* Direct my prayers Holy Spirit.

30. *So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. I Cor. 10:31* Holy Spirit, empower me.

31. *For from him & through him & to him are all things. To Him be glory forever. Amen Rom. 11:36* The whole goal of our salvation is to bring us to a place where **we worship God** & we **honor Him as God**. May this be our prayer today for ourselves, our family & TBC.
